**GRADE POINT AVERAGE WORKSHEET**

 (International applicants complete this form only if their school's grading system is similar to ours).

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Do not wait for Fall 2007 grades. Calculate three grade-point averages (as applicable to you). Transfer results to the GPA section on Page B2 of the paper or electronic Graduate Application for Admission and Fellowship and also submit this GPA worksheet by December 3. To calculate each GPA, look at your transcript and add up the total number of units (sometimes called credits) for which you've received an A and enter this amount in the "A" row under Units. Do the same with the other letter grades. Then, for each letter grade, multiply the Grade Value times the Units and put the result under Grade Points. Add together the Grade Points to get Total Grade Points. Add together the Units to get Total Units. Finally, divide Total Grade Points by Total Units and *voila*, a GPA! If you have a mixture of semester and quarter units, translate quarter units to semester units by using the following formula: quarter units x 2/3 = semester units.
